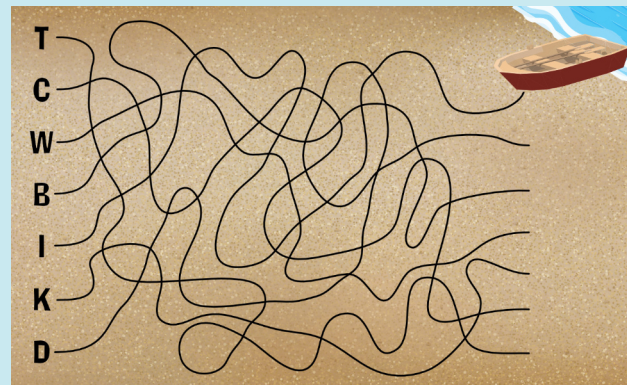
Puzzle For The Week
