Bible Time



In our bible story today, we looked at a time when Jesus was tempted. Being tempted does not mean that you do something wrong, but it means that either you think about doing something you know you shouldn't, or someone suggests/tempts you to do it.

During his 40 days in the desert with no food, Jesus would have become very weak and tired. God allowed the devil to tempt him with food, power, and wealth but Jesus knew what God's rules were. He knew the bible and that he needed to be obedient and follow what God said. He was able to say no and stand firm.

Have you ever been tempted to do something wrong? It can be really hard to resist especially if one of your friends is trying to persuade you. But as a Christian the bible tells us God's rules and also that we should obey them. God tells us not to lie or steal, to be jealous of others or put anyone above God. He has given us these rules as part of his wonderful treasure to help us obey him. But he doesn't just leave us alone to work it all out ourselves. If we talk to God, he will give us the strength we need to stand up against doing the wrong thing.

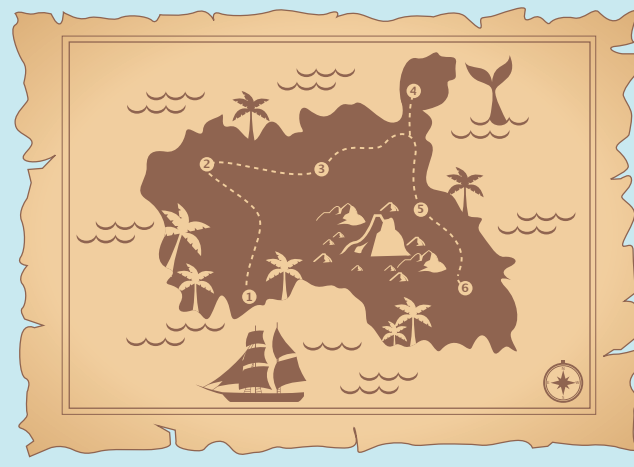
